To keep spectators – especially children – safe, <u>no candy or giveaways</u> will be handed out <u>along the parade route.</u>

Children have previously stepped into the roadway to grab items near large floats and trucks, which can be dangerous.

Giveaways will now be distributed exclusively during the Tree Lighting festivities at 5:00 PM.



Getting Downtown & Getting Around

We encourage guests to arrive early for the Light Parade festivities – and to be patient with increased traffic and crowds.

Parking:

- We recommend the Old Town Parking Structure for easy access.
- Check out <u>Parking Services</u> for more options.

Transit Options:

- Ride BATA to avoid traffic and road closures. The <u>Bayline shuttle</u> offers free rides to Front Street!
- Check routes and schedules at: <u>bata.net</u>

Accessible Seating Area:

A seating area for individuals with disabilities will be located at Park and Front Streets, with barricades and easy access.

Street Closures:

- Front Street will be closed at Grandview Parkway through Pine Street beginning at 3:00 PM on Saturday, Nov. 22. Vehicles will be towed after this time.
- Additional detours may be in place during staging and parade teardown.



Frequently Asked Questions

Can I put out chairs to reserve a viewing spot?

Yes, chairs may be placed on the sidewalk only. Chairs are to be placed no sooner than two hours before the parade and removed no later than two hours after the conclusion of the parade. Chairs may not block storefronts or be placed in front of barricades.

Can my children collect candy during the parade?

No. For safety, all treats and giveaways are part of the Tree Lighting festivities at 5:00 PM. There will be no handouts along the parade route. We ask everyone to remain on the sidewalk during the parade.

Where is the best place to watch the parade?

Front Street is fully walkable with great views but arrive early for the Accessible Seating Area at Park & Front Streets if needed.

Where can I see Santa?

- 6:00 PM: Santa lights the tree at Cass & Front.
- During the parade: Santa will be the last entry to come down the parade route.
- After the parade: Visit Santa's House at Cass & State (and through Dec. 24).

Is the parade still happening if it rains or snows?

Yes! The parade will march on through it all. If conditions are unsafe, it will be rescheduled for Tuesday, November 25, at the same time.

Can I bring pets?

For their safety and comfort, we recommend leaving pets at home due to large crowds and noise.

What time should I arrive?

We recommend arriving by 5:00 PM to enjoy the Tree Lighting festivities and secure a good viewing spot.
